"I treat my three-dimensional pieces as light traps or secret blueprints, in which by controlling the placement of its components, I'm able to create intriguing 3-D containers, their designs are then fully revealed by applying or pouring light into them."

J. Margulis is a contemporary Venezuelan artist whose work explores the boundaries between two and three-dimensional space. Margulis began producing acrylic, and aluminum wall sculptures made using photography, digital printing, and colorful plastic or aluminum sheets, affixing them onto surfaces, other times as free-standing struc-tures on a wall. He controls the placement of each three-dimensional component so that when light hits them their designs are fully re- vealed. Light is the impetus for his work to be fully expe- rienced, creating the illusions in which volume, space, and light shift before your eyes.
