



David Begbie

"Each work is an entity which has a far greater physical presence than any solid object could possibly have because it has the power to suggest that it doesn't exist."

David Begbie is a British sculptor who primarily sculpts in lightweight steel and bronze wiremesh, transforming the metal into dynamic three-dimensional figurative forms. His sculptures are contemporary archetypal renders of the human body that are as much about light as they are about substance. Strategic lighting creates optical compositions of line and form giving each transparent sculpture a greater palpable presence. Each sculpture is modeled using self-made tools and the wire-mesh is finished by joining each intersection so that the artwork is robust and stable for posterity. Begbie has exhibited a dozen European countries and the United States with over one hundred shows.
