Julien Marinetti is aFrench painter and sculptor, famous for his "Doggy John" sculptures, an on- going series of French bulldogs cast in bronze and finished with industrial lacquer. Marinetti describes these sculptures as three dimensional canvases or "support surfaces." His sculptures feature gestural paintings that reference current events or art-historical trends, along with the inspiration he draws from Picasso. In addition to the French bulldogs, he also makes penguins, pandas, teddy bears, cats, skulls, a n d ducks. Marinetti has site specific monumental sized sculptures in a dozen countries and is highly sought after by smart collectors world wide.
