Craig Alan is an internationally recognized contemporary fine artist. His work varies in subject from Realism to Abstract Expressionism, but he is mostly known for his Populus series which aligns groups of people seen from an aerial perspective to create a reimagined image. Each person is photographed from his rooftop at a 45-degree angle. From these pictures, he paints each individual using acrylic and oil on canvas or board with either a paintbrush or an airbrush. Each piece is finished with three coats of resin. Born in San Bernardino, California in 1971, he now lives in Atlanta, Georgia. Alan has year round international exhibitions, and is a frequent presence at major art fairs and has his work in the homes of many prominent collectors.
